

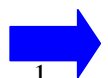
SIX OPTIONS FEEDBACK FORM

Option 2	Hospital, designated beds Provide palliative care in Ward 1, in 2 designated beds with non designated Staff
Option 4	Hospital Redesign Provide palliative care in Ward 1 and the hospice building with non designated beds and non designated staff
Option 5	Hospital Redesign Provide palliative care in Ward 1 and the hospice building with designated beds and designated staff
Option 7	Cowal Hospice Provide palliative care in Cowal Hospice with designated beds and staff
Option 9	Contracted services from a registered hospice Provide palliative care in Cowal Hospice and contract services from a registered consultant led hospice
Option 10	Branch of a registered hospice Provide palliative care in Cowal Hospice as a branch of a registered consultant led hospice
