## 1. Welcome and apologies

Rebecca Weir, Stuart MacPherson, David Sedgewick, Bryan Gregg, Malcolm Gillespie, Ian Langley, Stephen Gilbert and Michael Foxley.

#### 2. IA Update

Alan discussed the letter received from Scottish Government. The keys points highlighted were:

- The Capital Investment Group now invite the submission of an Outline Business Case.
- Healthcare Improvement Scotland have been working closely with the NHS Highland team on the project, but they have still to formally complete their internal governance review on whether this project constitutes Major Service Change. While the capital Investment group do not anticipate this review to create any surprises, they would expect your project team to address any recommendations or suggestions coming out of that review.
- The Capital Investment Group recognises that the Belford Hospital, built in 1965, is one of the oldest hospitals in Scotland and the clinical areas remain largely unchanged. The current building is functionally unsuitable and does not meet modern space standards or modern infection prevention and control standards. That is why we are keen for this project to proceed to the next phase of the business case process.
- However, the Scottish Government's infrastructure Investment Plan (IIP) details the
  projects the health portfolio will prioritise over the period 2021-22 until 2025-26 and the
  Lochaber redesign is not included in this plan. While the annual budget process will give
  the portfolio an opportunity to bid for additional capital funding, which may allow the
  project to be progressed without delay.

Alan confirmed this is a great milestone and will progress as normal with the project.

Donald Stewart stated that at a meeting with Kate Forbes on 20<sup>th</sup> June regarding the capital plan that Kate Forbes reported money was available. Alan confirmed the project will continue until the funding is released by Scottish Government. Alan confirmed he will circulate the NHS Highland Capital Plan to the Lochaber Health & Social Care Redesign Stakeholder Group for information.
