2 Report summary

2.1 Situation

This report outlines proposals for changes to Governance Committee memberships and Chair positions.

2.2 Background

At the meeting in November 2022, the Board revised the membership of its Governance Committees to maximise the contribution and experience of Board members and consolidate arrangements previously put in place following the Local Government elections in May that year.

Given the change to the Board Chair position and other imminent changes to the Board's membership, revisions to Committee memberships and chair positions

are now necessary to provide a degree of stability until the Board's full membership has been finalised.

2.3 Assessment

Arising from the change of Board Chair, the Board is currently operating with one less Non-Executive Board member. Other membership changes are also imminent, and discussions are being held with Scottish Government Public Appointments Team to recruit to these vacancies.

Until the vacancies have been filled and longer-term appointments can be made, the Board Chair has proposed interim changes to memberships and positions on Committees.

Appendix 1 to this report highlights the changes and **Appendix 2** illustrates the spread of Non-Executive memberships and appointments across all governance committees. The following provides a brief description of the changes:

Staff Governance Committee

- Ann Clark to be appointed to the Committee and to take the position of Interim Chair
- Jean Boardman, current Vice Chair, to cease Committee membership
- Philip Macrae to become Vice Chair of the Committee

Argyll and Bute Integration Joint Board

- Graham Bell to take the position of Vice Chair/Chair
- Sarah Compton Bishop to remain a member
- Jean Boardman to remain a member until her term of office concludes on 30 June 2023
