1. Welcome and apologies

Louise Bussell welcomed everyone to the meeting and noted the apologies above.

2. Minutes from previous meeting of 29th September 2022 and matters arising:

Community & Engagement Plan – Ruth Fry

<u>Jubilee event feedback</u> – Ruth confirmed the feedback from the public consisted of; to extend more services locally and travel and access provision. John Gillespie expressed an interest in receiving this feedback.

3. OBC Planning – Alan Wilson / Heather Cameron

It was confirmed the clinical workshops were going well.

Alan confirmed the next milestone for the project is the appointment of the PSCP which will be in March 2023. Work is ongoing in the meantime.

4. Transport Update – Alan Wilson / Heather Cameron

Concerns were raised around the parking allocation (currently 150 spaces) and whether this would be sufficient. Heather Cameron stated that the allocation appears adequate at present although once the modelling work has been concluded this will determine the exact requirements. Heather Cameron confirmed that the Highland Council's planning application for phase 2 housing will not affect parking on the site. The college parking will be a separate allocation.

Transport work with Hitrans for new build was on hold pending outcome of service design, so that any recommendations on transport work are based on new services rather than existing. Alan updated on bus link.

Alan confirmed meetings have taken place to address security concerns. PHP will discuss with GPs and update Alan in due course.
