Working with you to make Highland the healthy place to be

Welcome to the PDS Dental Clinic Inverness Dental Centre

This is a dental facility which provides wholly NHS dentistry; any items not available through the NHS would have to be provided privately. This would require the patient to find a private dentist who is willing to carry out private dental treatment. The clinic provides services to registered patients and patients referred by their own dentist, for example sedation services. The team also provide emergency dental services.

Patients are seen by appointment only. The clinic is open:

08.30 - 17.00hrs Monday - Friday

How do I get an appointment?

Telephone the Clinic Reception on 01463 255866 and ask for an appointment with your named dentist.



After your treatment is complete your dentist will advise you when your next check-up is due.

We recommend you go at least once every 2 years. However, for some patients, the dentist will ask you to go more regularly. If you need help to re-book, then please speak to the clinic's Reception staff.

We would like to see **all children** attend at least once a year.

The clinic staff will issue reminders for all patients.



What happens if I cannot attend an appointment?

Please contact the Clinic Reception as soon as possible as this will allow us to offer your appointment time to another patient. Another appointment can be arranged for you.

What should I do when I arrive at the Dental Clinic?

Report to the Clinic Reception and then go to the waiting area. You may be asked to fill in a medical questionnaire. If you are taking any medicines, please make sure you tell the dental staff **before** any treatment is carried out.

Who works at the Dental Clinic?

Dental teams working for NHS Highland. This includes dentists, hygienists, therapists and dental support staff.

Dental professionals must be registered with the General Dental Council and meet their standards. Further details are available at www.gdc-uk.org.

What if I have a friend or relative who is not currently registered with a dentist?

To request registration with a dentist telephone the NHS Dental Helpline on 0800 141 2362

Some patients, such as children, will be prioritised into care.

Do I have to pay for treatment?

The dental clinic provides NHS dental services and normal NHS charges apply. If you are exempt from payment, you must bring evidence of your exemption when



you go for each appointment. If you are unsure whether you can get free dental treatment, the Reception staff will be able to help you.

Facilities include:

- Patient waiting area
- Baby feeding and changing room
- Toilets
- Hearing Loop system
- BSL, foreign language and interpreting services

If you have limited mobility you may wish to contact the Dental Clinic directly before you attend to ensure that it will be accessible for you.

If you have any other needs, please telephone the clinic before you come. You may instead speak to a member of Reception staff when you arrive.

Patients requiring personal care should attend with a carer.

How do I get emergency care?

If you are registered with a dentist at the clinic and require urgent care please telephone the Clinic Reception on 01463 255866. You may be seen at another PDS dental clinic for this emergency appointment.

For out of hours emergency care, please contact NHS 24 on 111.

Where is the Dental Clinic?

The Dental Clinic is part of the larger UHI House which is round the back of Raigmore Hospital. The entrance is on the right-hand side of the building.
