

Skye, Lochalsh and South West Ross Community Hospital

Project Newsletter – December 2019

Balfour Beatty are now 15 weeks+ into the construction phase for the new Skye, Lochalsh and South West Ross Community Hospital and Healthcare facility based in Broadford on the Isle of Skye.

Since commencing on site in August, the Project team have made good progress with earthworks, piling and foundations all in advance of the primary steel frame erection planned for January 2020.

The new NHS Highland facility is scheduled for completion by Spring 2021 and will feature departments including Emergency, X-ray, Maternity and Outpatients containing an Infusion Suite and Physiotherapy gym. The top floor will be utilised by a 24 bed inpatient unit.
